CIA 13-01 re SELAPs When an individual holds an Ed Specialist Credential in the specialty are of Mild/Moderate Disabilities & is seeking an initial SELAP in Moderate/ Severe Disabilities (or vice versa), the applicant will not be required to verify completion of the three semester units of coursework or the one year of experience noted in Option 4, due to the significant areas of overlap between the two authorizations. Thus, those candidates may be considered as having met this requirement toward obtaining the initial SELAP.

In addition, employing agencies may choose to submit an application for the Ed Specialist Credential in Mild/Moderate credential holder requesting the Added Authorization in Special Education (AASE) waiver in Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). It is not necessary for employing agencies to apply for the SELAP in Moderate/Severe if the individual only needs the additional authorization in ASD to be appropriately assigned; this is the employer’s choice as to which document to request. However, individuals holding the Moderate/Severe credential must apply for the SELAP in Mild/Moderate as these is no AASE specialty area available for the waiver that would expand their authorization.
