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## Appropriate Use of the TPSL

Type of Leave	Timeframe
Sick Leave	As accumulated by teacher
Differential Sick Leave	5 months
Pregnancy Disability Leave Act	4 months
Family and Medical Leave	12 workweeks
California Family Rights Act	12 workweeks
Industrial Accident and Illness Leave	60 days

*Not appropriate for teacher vacancies*



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## TPSL Permit Structure

- Single document issued with specific authorization(s)
  - Statutory Single Subject Areas
  - Multiple Subjects
  - Special Education
- Restricted to Employing Agency
- Can serve for full length of statutory leave
- Renewable **ANNUAL**
- **VALID FOR ENTIRE COUNTY**

1) 1 OR 2 WHATEVER THEY QUALIFY FOR  
 2) CAN BE A DAY TO DAY SUB, WILL NOT NEED A SUB

## Coded Correspondence

### 16-02: Proposed Addition and Amendments to Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations Pertaining to Teaching Permit for Statutory Leave (TPSL)

Announces the Public Hearing for the proposed regulations that will create the TPSL to be used when a teacher of record is unable to provide instruction due to a statutory leave.

#### Q. TPSL – Estimated time on actually being able to apply for it.

*The Public Hearing is scheduled for June 16 at 9:00 a.m. If approved by the Commission, the proposed regulations and amendments will be submitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for final review. OAL will have 30 business days to review and approve or deny the regulations. If approved by OAL, the regulations will take effect on October 1, 2016, unless we ask for an "effective upon filing" date (meaning the regulations will take effect on the date they are filed with the Secretary of State).*

#### Q. Clarification of the number of hours of training they need before getting the initial TPSL.

*Initial issuance of a TPSL, as proposed, will require verification of 45 hours of pre-service preparation that shall include, but is not limited to, the following:*

- *Foundational level content covering Curriculum and Instruction.*
- *Foundational level content covering Reading and Language Arts.*
- *Foundational level content covering Pedagogy.*
- *Foundational level content covering Human Development.*
- *Foundational level content covering Teaching English Learners.*
- *Foundational level content covering Best Practices in Instruction and Individualized Education Programs.*
- *Foundational, intermediate, and proficient level content for Health, Safety and Hygiene.*
- *Foundational, intermediate, and proficient level content for Ethics.*
- *Foundational, intermediate, and proficient level content for Local Context.*
- *Foundational level content covering Classroom Management and the Learning Environment*

*The proposed regulations include amendments to Title 5 section 80025.3 to allow holders of Provisional Internship Permits, Short-Term Staff Permits, and TPSLs to provide services as day-to-day substitute teachers and to clarify the number of days an individual may substitute in one classroom in a school year (30 days for general education and 20 days for special education).*

## Credential Information Alerts (CIAs)

### 16-01: College and University Transcripts

Clarifies the type of documentation that is acceptable to verify conferral of a degree or course work completion, depending on who submits an application to the Commission, as follows:

- Applicant:
  - Original official transcripts required
- Employing agency:

- Original or photocopies of official transcripts; or
- Electronic transcripts that were transmitted directly to employing agency
- Program sponsor:
  - Original or photocopies of official transcripts;
  - Electronic transcripts that were transmitted directly to program sponsor; or
  - Unofficial transcripts if program sponsor granted degree

Photocopies of diplomas, Registrar letters, and WORD documents are no longer acceptable for degree or course work verification!
